Discover Your Family in Norwegian Church Books and Farm Books

Plan now to take part in NAGA's next genealogy seminar. We'll dig into two of the most important types of records from Norway and show you how to make the most of them.

Church records: Did you know that clergy recorded more than just names and dates for events like baptisms and marriages? Learn to spot other clues in their notes and discover additional lists that clergy kept, of religious dissenters, emigrants departing their home parishes, and more. We'll show you how to find and search these records online.

Farm histories: You might have heard these called by their Norwegian name, *bygdebøker*. They are locally produced histories of Norway's rural communities, including detailed genealogies of the families who lived on area farms. We'll show you how and where to access these books and how to use them.
